Telegraph Gallery broadcasts third signal from the Robert Runták Collection

How do František Kupka and Jan Zrzavý relate to pop art or performance art? This is not the only question answered by the exhibition SIGNAL III: Masterpieces from the Robert Runták Collection (1900-1990), prepared by the Telegraph Gallery in Olomouc. The exhibition will open on Thursday 28 July at 6 pm and the list of artists and -isms will be truly diverse. You will be able to see it in Olomouc until 11 September.

The exhibition presents over hundred works of art by about ninety artists from the Robert Runták Collection. Paintings, prints, photographs, as well as sculptures and objects are represented and divided into eight sections. Mark Ther took charge of the architectural aspect of the exhibition and created an original and unusual exhibition space for galleries. Art historian David Voda, who opened a new exhibition space Rub Gallery in Olomouc this year, was invited as curator.

The ninety-year span of the curator's selection allows the gallery to present not only the most famous names of Czech art, but also offers the possibility of an extensive overview of 20th century art -isms. David Voda, the curator of the exhibition, has attempted to list the presented artistic movements with a certain amount of exaggeration: *"Art Nouveau, Impressionism, Cubism, Orphism, Expressionism, Civilism, Artificialism, Symbolism, Primitivism, Surrealism, Social Art, Neoclassicism, Magic Realism, Existentialism, Informel, Neo-constructivism, Lettrism, Minimalism, Lyrical Abstraction, Nouveau Réalisme, Pop-art, Op-art, New Figuration, Postmodernism, Neo-avant-garde, Performance Art, Actionism, Land-art, Happening, Visual Poetry, Feminism, Neo-geo, Neo-expressionism, Ost-pop, Neue Wilde, Czech Grotesque, Conceptualism, Installation Art, Environment..."* However, it should be emphasized that even this list is not complete.

Among the exhibited artists who have also made their mark abroad, we should mention Jan Zrzavý, František Kupka, Adriena Šimotová, Josef Čapek, Emil Filla, Jindřich Štyrský, Eduard Ovčáček, Stanislav Kolíbal, Karel Malich and Petr Nikl.

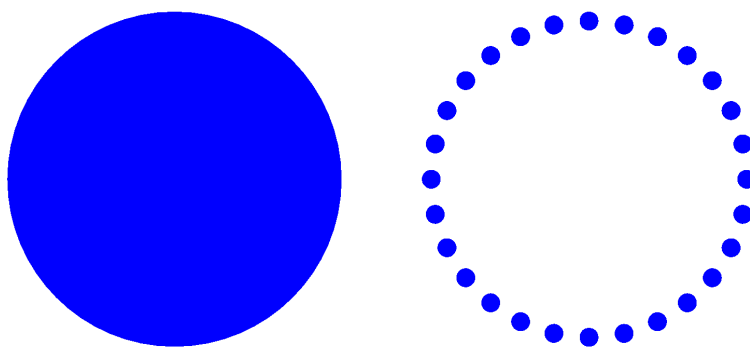

SIGNAL is a series of regular art shows that present art from the Robert Runták Collection. The curator becomes acquainted with the collection only during the preparation of the exhibition. His choice is thus not based on continuous work and long-standing knowledge of the collection, but rather on aesthetic sensibility and personal taste. The curator has no limitations in selection or in installation. The curators Martin Drábek and David Vojtuš conceived SIGNAL I as a probe into the mind of a passionate art collector. SIGNAL II, prepared by curator Pavel Dvořák, presented artworks where the leitmotif is the loss of the physical experience from an artwork materialized in the metaphor of disappearance.
